



To avoid the problems experienced last year - when the Town's mini-roundabouts and railway bridge failed to cope with the increase in visitors to the Show and holiday traffic - we have devised a new road system so Show goers can avoid Moreton Town Centre. Please have a look at the map and use the coloured routes on your way to the show and then follow the road signs directing you to specific car parks. To help speed up the flow of traffic ticket money will now be taken as you enter the showground on foot – after having parked your car.

The car park charge has been absorbed into ticket prices which is why they seem more expensive. However, for many, the cost of coming to the show is actually lower than last year. It is important to note a family ticket now includes three children which again represents even better value.

Disabled visitors will share the Members' Car Park ensuring they get to park as close to the showground entrance as possible but, as with Members' own parking, is only reserved until 1pm.
