RULES

1. All competitors to plough ground allotted to them. All ploughmen to start at 9.30am prompt and finish at 1.30pm. If competitors not out in time will have pegs taken up. Competitors must compete in the class they have entered. Splits to be ready to judge at 10.00am
2. All classes must split open. The splits will be judged.
3. All entries by **Friday 15th October 2021**
4. Any competitor seen manipulating the furrow or receiving assistance with their work will have 20 points deducted. Points will also be deducted for incorrect depth.
5. All competitors to have Public Liability Insurance
6. Competitors risk disqualification if out of time
7. Drag chains will be allowed.

VINTAGE RULES

1. Trailing Plough Class:
Tractor: Model to have been in production before 31st December 1959 and to be as manufactured.
Plough: Any make of trailing plough
Mounted Plough Class:
Tractor: Model to have been in production before 31st December 1959 and to be as manufactured.
Plough: Any make of mounted plough in production before 31st December 1959 and to be as manufactured.
2. Plough bodies designed for the plough at the time of manufacture
3. Skimmers and one-piece tailpieces optional; no other attachments allowed.
4. Mounted Class: slotted or quick entry top links allowed, except class 3
5. Hydraulic rams and hydraulic top links not allowed.
6. Depth of ploughing is 6 inches minimum and 8 inches maximum.
7. Tractors: approved manufacturers diesel engine conversions allowed.
8. All other Society of Ploughman ploughing rules must be adhered to.
9. All ploughs will be inspected before ploughing commences.
10. Any new rules made since schedule go to print, must be adhered to.
11. Classic class: to plough 7 inches deep. Tractors and ploughs must comply with the Classic Rules 1960 – 1976 pre Q cabs.
12. Ferguson Class: to plough 6 inches minimum depth. Screw top links allowed.
